

Louisiana Prophetic Declarations

Job 22:28, *“Thou shalt also decree a thing, and it shall be established unto thee: and the light shall shine upon thy ways.”*

We, the Church of Louisiana, *“bless the children of Israel, saying unto them, The Lord bless thee, and keep thee: the Lord make His face shine upon thee, and be gracious unto thee: the Lord lift up His countenance upon thee, and give thee peace.”* Numbers 6:23b-26

We, the Church of Louisiana, decree Isaiah 33:22 over Louisiana that “The Lord is our Judge, the Lord is our Law-giver, and the Lord is our King. He will save us.”

We, the Church of Louisiana, decree that we have come out of the place of unrighteous government, that the government of God has arisen in Louisiana, and that Louisiana has become a stronghold for the government of God; for God has said in Psalm 125:3, “...the scepter of wickedness shall not rest on the land allotted to the righteous...”

We, the Church of Louisiana, declare that we have chosen God’s government and will walk under a governmental mantle and authority that will cause a shift in the government of our nation both in the spirit and the natural.

We, the Church of Louisiana, decree that we have shut the door to revelry in this state and opened the door to the King of Glory. We declare a change of sound in New Orleans. We declare a sound of worship to King Jesus!

We, the Church of Louisiana, decree that Louisiana is no longer a stronghold of evil, but a place that exhibits His covenant, a place of refuge, a place of wholeness, a place of friendship, a place of intimacy and fellowship with God. We choose to receive the Caleb anointing, the giant slaying anointing from the Lord. We cut off rebellion and unrighteousness from Louisiana in the name of Jesus, and decree that the eyes of the nation will rest upon Louisiana because of righteousness and covenantal wholeness.

We, the Church of Louisiana, declare that the Dagon of covetousness which is idolatry is fallen.

We, the Church of Louisiana, put on the mantle of victory and declare that we are overcomers and that our enemies are bread for us.

We, the Church of Louisiana, declare that God has taken us to Gilgal and rolled away the reproach from us. We decree that God is cutting away those in political realms that are not aligning with His purposes and we decree that new, fresh, righteous leadership is arising in Louisiana.

We, the Church of Louisiana, decree that God has realigned Louisiana according to His purposes and intents for this state, that He has brought His shalom to this state: His wholeness, His peace, His rest. We declare that Louisiana will transport, pray, and decree shalom into the rest of the nation.

We, the Church of Louisiana, decree that barrenness is broken and no longer rules in this state. We declare that the womb of Louisiana has been cleansed from hostility and the deadness of unbelief that has caused miscarriage. We declare that righteousness has now been conceived and will come to birth. We declare the protection of God according to Revelation 12 over this womb.

We, the Church of Louisiana, declare that we will obediently follow the Lord, that we will receive His promises. We declare that there will be a supernatural conversion going on all over this state, and a supernatural transference going on in this state.

We, the Church of Louisiana, decree that Louisiana is filled with faith, that Louisiana is coming up out of the wilderness, and that God has raised up a people who are expert in war according to Song of Solomon 3:8. We declare that the army of God in Louisiana has come together bone to bone in unity and stood upon their feet, an exceeding great army. We now prophesy to the wind of God and say breathe upon this army. We speak to the dry bones and say let hope arise in your hearts for God has spoken and He will perform it!

We, the Church of Louisiana, decree that there is much supply in Louisiana. We speak to that supply and say be opened and released to the people of God, and we declare the transference of wealth into God's Kingdom now!

We, the Church of Louisiana, decree break-through for the harvest of God. We address the spirit of pharaoh that has held the people of Louisiana and we say, "Let God's people go that they may serve and worship the Lord!"
